Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT TOGETHER (choose 1-2)

1. What is something you are thankful for this week?
2. How have you seen Jesus at work in the world around you? How have you been able to join him? Remember, God works through small stories.
3. Are you facing a challenge right now?
4. From Sunday’s message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?

READ Revelation 12:11, Psalm 51:16-17, and Ezekiel 36:26

1. After all passages are read, have different people retell each passage in their own words.
2. What stands out as significant, surprising, interesting, confusing, or powerful?
3. How do each of these passages relate to our walk as followers of Jesus?
4. What are the various ways we can “die” as a follower of Jesus (Rev.12:11)?
5. What does it mean to have a heart of stone transform into a heart of flesh (Ezek.36:26)?
6. What does a “broken and contrite heart” (Ps 51:16-17, NIV) look like?
7. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
8. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

1. In what specific ways can you apply these passages, as individuals and in your relationship with others?
2. How are these passages calling us to live as a group?
