

“Some Assembly Required” Discussion Questions

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT TOGETHER (choose 1-2)

1. What is something you are thankful for this week?
2. Have you asked the question, “What does love require?” since last time? Did it change anything you might have done?
3. Are you facing a challenge right now?
4. From Sunday’s message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?

READ Matthew 22:1-14

1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
2. What stands out as significant, surprising, interesting, confusing, or powerful?
3. All people are invited, but not all people choose to accept God’s invitation. In your opinion, what are the everyday consequences of doing life your own way?
4. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
5. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

LIVE IT OUT

1. In what ways can you apply today’s passage?
2. How is this passage calling our group to live out God’s mission to bless others?
3. Read **Revelation 19:6-9**. What do you think the meaning is that the Bride is ready and clothed in white?
