

The Quest Discussion Questions (9/3/23)

Week 5 - Psalm 23 - John Molloy

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT Questions (choose 1-2)

1. Pick one:
 - a. What TV show could you see yourself being part of and what part would you want to play?
 - b. If you had a parrot, what would you teach it to say?
2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
3. Are you facing a challenge right now?
4. Share a story where you see Jesus at work in the world around you and how you've been able to join him. Remember, God works through small stories.

READ Psalm 23

1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
2. What stands out, is surprising, or interesting to you?
3. Is asking others for help easy, difficult, uncomfortable, etc??? If it's difficult, what could others do to make you more comfortable?
4. If you see someone you know and can tell by the look they are hurting or burdened, are you comfortable approaching them?
5. Do you have any advice on how to approach someone in a comfortable manner who looks like they might need a friend, or a prayer, or help?
6. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
7. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

LIVE IT OUT

1. How can you apply this passage this week? (Create an "I Will..." statement")
2. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
