

## **Life Group Questions**

### *One Question Series – Should We Care About Social Justice?*

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). It's good to begin with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

#### **CONNECT Questions**

1. What has needs injustices, and/or inequalities has God made you aware of concerning the world around you?
2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
3. Share something you are thankful for or a challenge you are facing right now.
4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

#### **READ Isaiah 58:1-11**

1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
2. What stands out or is interesting to you?
3. How is social justice Good News to the world?
4. Why do you think God's people so often do not live out Good News to those who are suffering injustice and inequality?
5. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
6. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

#### **LIVE IT OUT**

1. What needs, injustices, and inequalities are you aware of in the world around you?
2. What is God speaking to your heart about concerning these needs?
3. How can you apply this passage this week? (Create an "I Will..." statement")
4. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
